1. Which time term I shall choose for the course?

2. In which language is the course?

It is in English, but the recognition of the certificate is worldwide.

3. How many hours I need to attend by week and which exact hours?

The course takes place online so that students receive the materials prepared by the teachers on a weekly basis and can study at their preferred times. They do not have to commit to specific hours of their daily programme. There will be two live sessions as a Q & A session and presentation of the ECU1 seminar that is part of the course.

5. What is expected from the students?

- The students must read all the written materials given.*
- There will be tests for section 1, 2, 4 and 5 made online. If there are no sufficient results the students must make the test again till an approved result is given.*
- The students must write summaries with reflections on scientific studies, books, and instruction materials for sections 3, 4 and 6.*
- The students will dig deeper into one method of CIE work and present their own project.*
- The students shall take part in an ECU EDU two-day course online, and manage the test connected to this course.*
